General Construction

Pipe Line Tapes are made as a lamination of PVC tape printed on the surface and Polypropylene tape applied over the print. The individual specifications of each component are given below.

Service Life

Very dependant on external conditions. Service temperatures: 0°C to 45°C. Films and adhesives will not stand temperatures above 60°C. Rubber based adhesives are degraded by UV light.

Typically in UK external inland conditions a service life in excess of 12 months will be acheived.

All colours and designs conform to BS 1710 : 1984, BS 4800.

Peel adhesion	180gm/cm
Tensile	186N/25mm
