


# Plumbing Chrome Plated Tubes Data Sheet



## BS EN 1057 /BS EN 1456

### Material Analysis

Material Grade Phosphorus de-oxidised copper; Cu-DHP or CW024A as defined in BS EN 1976  
Minimum Copper Content 99.90 % (including silver)  
Phosphorus 0.015-0.040 %  
Total Impurity Maxima 0.060 % (excluding phosphorus and silver)  
The melting point of copper is 1083°C and it has a density of 8.9 gm/cc  
Chrome coating as per ISO 1456:2009

### Packaging

All chrome plated tubes are individually bagged to ensure they are protected during transport

### Marking

Sizes 15 - 54mm copper tubes are stamped with:

- Tube size
- Kitemark
- EN 1057
- Temper
- Manufacturer
- Date (quarter)

### Notes
